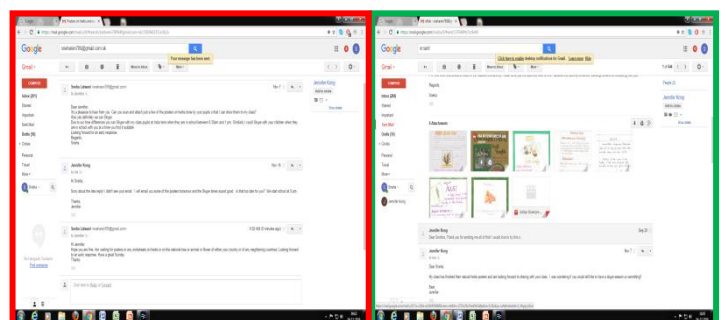
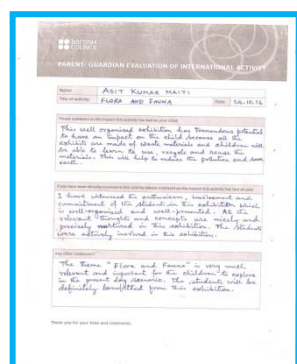

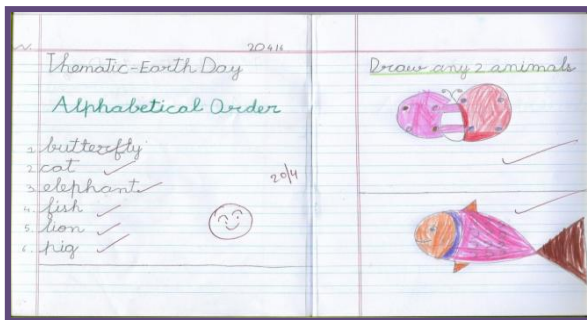

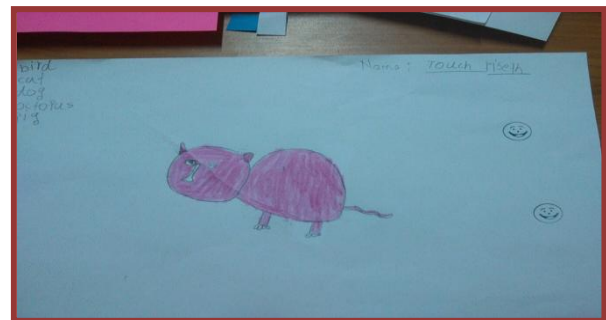

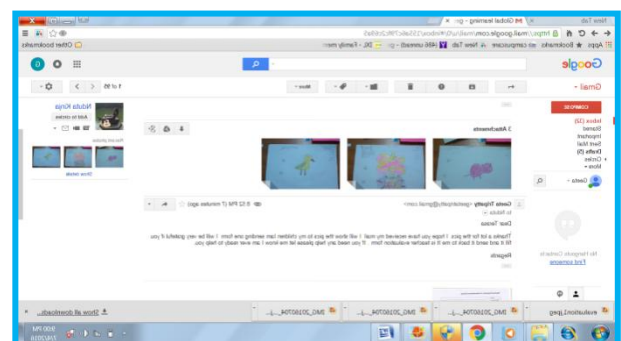
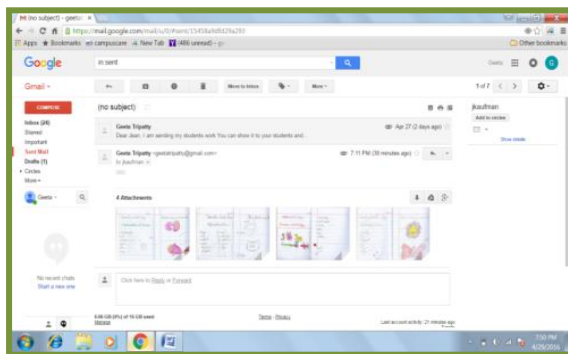
Pupils of Birla High School arranged names of animals in alphabetical order:
