2. Does the school provide any transport?

Transport is not provided by the school and we take no responsibility for carpools.

3. How do we get the school diary?

The school diary is given by the Class teacher once the new session commences.

4. Is there any half-day facility for the students?

We do not have any system for half day. Children will not be allowed to leave early or come in late to school.

5. Are children allowed to enter school late?

Children are not allowed to enter school late. After 3 days of being late in a month, strict action will be taken. The child is also liable to be sent home.

6. How are parents notified about important updates or assignments?

Children are encouraged to write notes in the diary. However, parents get notified about attendance, assignments and circulars through Campus Care portal. All circulars are uploaded in our school website. Teachers also notify parents through WhatsApp in the class group. Updates about daily activities are posted in the Google Classroom.

7. Are Activity Based Learning (ABL) classes and Clubs compulsory?

Activity Based Learning (ABL) classes are held every Wednesday for the students of Class I & II. Timings are as follows:

- for class I: from 12:45 p.m. to 1:30 p.m.
- for class II: from 12:45 p.m. to 1:35 p.m.
- for UKG from 12- 12:30 p.m.

Clubs are held every Wednesday for the students of classes III, IV & V from 12:45 p.m. – 1:45 p.m.

Both the above are held during school hours and therefore compulsory.

8. Are the extracurricular classes after school compulsory?

Extracurricular classes are held for the students of classes III, IV & V only. These classes are optional for the students and are held after school on the specified days mentioned in the diary.

9. Is school closed on rainy days, rallies/bandhs?

School is open on all these days. Parents should use their discretion in sending their wards to school unless otherwise notified.

10. Are parents allowed to meet the teachers in the morning?

Parents are not allowed to meet the teachers in the morning or during school hours. Please follow the days and timings mentioned in the school diary for the same.

11. Are Tiffin Boxes or Water Bottles allowed to be sent later?

Tiffin boxes or water bottles will not be accepted by security or the school office after school has begun.

If the child forgets his tiffin box/water bottle, he will be provided with food/ water at school.

12. Are Escort cards compulsory for dispersal?

Yes, the **Escort card** is compulsory.

Children are not allowed to leave the school without the Escort card. Only parents will be issued a gate pass (if necessary) if they fail to produce the Escort card during dispersal. A child **will not** be dispersed against his Fee Book or any other document.

13. What is the purpose of an Escort Card and a Student Identity Card?

Dispersals are done only against an Escort card whereas pupils are expected to wear the Student Identity Card to school daily.

14. What will happen if an escort forgets to carry the Escort Card to school?

No gate pass will be issued to the **<u>carpool drivers/any other relativc /house help /etc</u>**. Hence, the child will have to wait in school till the parents come or send someone with the Escort Card.
