



Colours are the smiles of nature.


The little wonders of Nursery celebrated Colour




### **Independence Day**

### World Book Day




Students of Birla High School enjoyed the story telling sessions in their Library on the World Book Day on 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2022.









# Coding

The students are given exposure to a variety of coding exercises which is the foundation of Artificial Intelligence.




















# Awards & Accolades
