Students of Classes II, III and IV celebrated World Book Day during their Story Telling classes. They dressed up as their favourite characters and enacted portions from different stories.






Khushal Agarwal of KG entered the 'India Book of Records' for the 'Fastest Recitation of the Hanuman Chalisa' by a child.










Class
